Following a resignation, a vacancy to be filled by co-option in the West Ward arises. The Council is therefore seeking nominations of suitable candidates.

If you are interested in being a Town Councillor, please contact the Proper Officer at the address below by **20th December 2024**.

A prospective councillor must be qualified by virtue of being a British or Commonwealth Citizen, Citizen of the Republic of Ireland or European Union citizen, who has attained the age of 18 years and is:

- (a) registered as a local government elector for the parish; and/or who has
- (b) during the whole of the twelve months preceding the appointment occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the parish; and/or his/her
- (c) principal or only place of work during those twelve months has been in the parish; and/or has
- (d) during those twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 kilometres of it; and is not disqualified from holding office by reason of any disqualification set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.
