c) Cllr R. Hall gave a brief overview of the OVERSIGHT Committee Meeting of 4th December 2024 and highlighted items on this meeting's Agenda (items 7 and 8). 10. Policy - Use of Artificial Intelligence

Following consideration, it was **resolved by majority (9:1)** to adopt the proposed policy, aimed at future proofing governance arrangements for the use of Al tools, where appropriate. Proposed Cllr Ebbs, seconded Cllr Gilmore. **WTC/FC/31/2425**
